[Free Spanish Language Courses To Be Offered At Eton Institute After Popular Demand:](#)

Dubai, 13 July 2010 - Eton Institute, a prominent language institute based in Dubai Knowledge Village, announced that they will be hosting free language courses in Spanish for the public, for an entire month, as part of a CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) initiative to promote language diversity and education. Spanish, the third most commonly spoken language in the world, is the official language of over 20 countries, spoken by over 400 million people worldwide. Due to its widespread nature, the language has evolved into many different variations and dialects after adopting unique characteristics from the different places where it is spoken. Castilian Spanish spoken mainly in Spain and Latin American Spanish predominant in South and North America are the two most popularly recognized variants of the language.

Dr. Eli added “El Mundo de Español - the Spanish speaking world, extends over four continents. Learning Spanish can take you a long way, all around the world!”

The FREE Spanish course will cover an entire beginner level in the language with classes being conducted from 18 July-12 August, three times a week, Sundays, Tuesdays & Thursdays, from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm.
